



Canada 150 Mini Grant FAQ

This program is a joint venture between the Centre Wellington Community Foundation (CWCF), Community Foundations of Canada (CFC). The Canada 150th Mini Grants application form is completely differently from the CWCF Mini Grant application form.

This grant program is a 1:1 matching program. This means that the applicant must match every dollar granted with either cash or in-kind. The maximum available on this grant program is \$2,000 which means if granted the maximum, your project will be worth at least \$4,000.

How to apply for the Canada 150 Mini Grant?


The application is made online. You can download the application to work offline then submit (upload) it when completed. You should send a copy to CWCF before submitting so we can review it with you.
