



Fourteen Projects Grants totalling \$19,000 awarded to community groups

ABOYNE – On May 3, recipients of the Centre Wellington Community Foundation’s (CWCF) Project Grants program were officially announced at a public Community Update and Project Grants event. A total of \$19,000 supporting 14 projects were given out. Grants supported youth, the environment, education, mental health, food insecurity, and the Arts.
