## Centre Wellington Community Foundation (CWCF) Mini-Grant Program Opens April 15th

The Centre Wellington Community Foundation (CWCF) is launching its 6th Mini-Grant program with the goal of providing numerous grants of up to \$1000 to various charities working in Centre Wellington. Since 2012 the foundation has provided approximately 50 grants to local projects and initiatives ranging from \$500-\$1000 each.

"We will be accepting applications for the 2017 mini-grants offered by the Foundation starting April 15, 2017. This year the selection will be based on the same criteria as last year - being the 2015 Vital Signs report. We are also adding flair to our granting due to it being Canada 150. If your project fits the Canada 150 guidelines, you may submit your application & may be awarded additional funding.

The mini-grant program will welcome applications from local registered non-profits that are building community capacity in the granting priority areas of CWCF. The grants can be used to support operational or project costs. All Mini-Grant applicants must be either a registered charity or must partner with an organization that has charitable status.
